About the programme

The Master of Public Administration (MPA) programme is customised to equip you with a global-Asian perspective in decision-making, governance, policy design and implementation. Throughout the programme, you will be exposed to real-world issues, engage in strategic transnational policies, and glean key insights from senior public officers and faculty members.

The programme is fully taught in English and aims to connect and groom public administrators and leaders throughout Asia. The MPA programme is open to both full-time and part-time students.

Period of study

Full-time	1 year (2 semesters)
Part-time	1.5 – 2 years (3 – 4 semesters)*

^{*}Maximum candidature of 4 years (8 semesters)


There are two semesters in a year with 13 teaching weeks per semester.

Programme structure

2 Core Courses + 6 Elective Courses + Capstone Paper

Out of the 6 elective courses, you will have the option to select up to two relevant courses from the other graduate programmes of NCPA and selected Schools as electives to fulfil your course requirement*.

Admission requirements

- A bachelor's degree in good standing from an accredited university or college is required for all applicants.
- Minimum of two years' or more of full-time work experience.
- For applicants whose native language is not English, or students from universities where English is not the medium of instruction, a good IELTS/TOEFL test score is required.

Application period

The programme offers two intakes each year.
